

Safety Instructions for the Installation and Use of a Hybrid Glass Screen Protector

1. Preparation before installation

- Choose a clean, dust-free and well-lit location with a flat surface.
- Wash your hands thoroughly before installation to avoid leaving greasy marks on the glass or screen.
- Turn off the device before starting the application so you can clearly see any contaminants on the screen.
- Make sure you have all necessary accessories: wet cleaning wipe, dry microfibre cloth, Dust-Pad™ stickers for removing dust.

2. Safe application of the glass

- Clean the screen with the enclosed wet wipe, then wipe dry with a soft microfibre cloth.
- Use the Dust-Pad™ stickers to remove remaining dust particles — even small contaminants can cause air bubbles.
- Hold the glass by the edges only — do not touch the adhesive side, as fingerprints reduce adhesion.
- Centre the glass over the speaker, camera and buttons. If the kit includes positioning stickers, use them as guides.
- Once placed, press the glass from the centre outward using a dry cloth or the enclosed card.
- Hybrid glass is flexible, but do not intentionally bend it or apply point pressure to the edges.
- The glass is single-use — once removed, it loses its adhesive properties and cannot be reinstalled. The kit contains 2 pieces — always clean the screen thoroughly before applying the second one.

3. After installing the glass

- Avoid pressing too hard on the glass edges, especially when the phone is not in a case.
- Regularly check the condition of the glass — if cracks, chips or touchscreen issues appear, replace it immediately.

4. Use and maintenance

- Regularly clean the glass surface with a microfibre cloth. Avoid aggressive chemical agents.
- Hybrid glass provides additional screen protection but is not indestructible. Drops from height or impacts can damage it.
- Avoid contact with sharp objects (keys, knives, needles).
- Avoid extreme temperatures — they may weaken the adhesive layer.
- We recommend using the glass together with a 3mk protective case for full device protection.

5. Handling damaged glass

- Remove damaged glass carefully — lever up a corner with a piece of paper or fingernail and peel off slowly.
- Do not use metal or sharp tools — they may scratch the screen.
- Exercise caution with cracked glass — edges may be sharp and cause cuts.
- Dispose of used glass in accordance with local glass waste regulations.

Following the above guidelines will ensure correct application and use of the product, keeping your device safe. The manufacturer is not liable for damage resulting from improper installation or use contrary to these instructions.
