3mk DriveLink Duo™

Product presentation

"3mk DriveLink Duo" – an ultra-fast CarPlay adapter that provides seamless wireless communication. Equipped with Bluetooth 5.4 and dual-band Wi-Fi 6 (2.4 GHz / 5 GHz) for maximum connection stability.

### I. Package contents:

### II. Specification:

**Interface:** USB (depending on version: USB-A / USB-C)

**Power Supply:** 5 V DC (USB), recommended 1 A

**Operating temperature range:** -20°C to +60°C (according to the device/package label)

The device only works in vehicles with factory-activated wired Apple CarPlay or wired Android Auto. It does not add these features to vehicles that do not have them.

Frequency range:

Bluetooth: 2402–2480 MHz

Wi-Fi 2.4 GHz: 2412–2484 MHz

Wi-Fi 5 GHz: 5180–5825 MHz

Maximum transmit power:

Bluetooth: <10 dBm

Wi-Fi: <20 dBm

Use: inside the vehicle

### III. Important information and safety warnings:

For your safety and the safety of other road users:

Perform configuration and setting changes only while stationary. Do not operate the device while driving.

Only use with 5 V power (USB).

Do not connect to other power sources.

Do not use the device at temperatures outside the range specified in the specifications.

Protect from water, moisture, and direct sunlight.

Do not disassemble the device or attempt to open it.

Do not use if the case, connector, or cable is damaged.

The product is not a toy. Keep out of reach of children.

\*The device uses Bluetooth and Wi-Fi radio technology.

Ensure that its use complies with the regulations applicable in your country.

### IV. Compatibility:

- Vehicles with factory wired Apple CarPlay or wired Android Auto.

- iPhone with iOS 10 or later.

- Android smartphone with Android 11 or later supporting Android Auto.

### V. Connection method and initial setup:

#### Apple CarPlay (wirelessly) - first connection:

1. Start the vehicle and wait for the multimedia system to power on.
2. Connect the adapter to the factory USB port supporting wired CarPlay.
3. On your iPhone, enable Bluetooth and Wi-Fi.
4. In Bluetooth Settings, select the device starting with "3mk-Drivelink."
5. Confirm pairing and the message "Use CarPlay."
6. After a moment, Apple CarPlay will automatically launch in wireless mode.
7. For CarPlay to launch, the **Siri** feature must be enabled in the phone settings.

#### VI. Android Auto (wirelessly) - first connection:

1. Start the vehicle.
2. Connect the adapter to the factory USB port supporting wired Android Auto.
3. On your phone, enable Bluetooth and Wi-Fi.

4. In Bluetooth Settings, select the device starting with "3mk-Drivelink."

5. Confirm pairing according to the messages on the phone and vehicle screen.

6. After a moment, Android Auto will automatically launch.

Automatic connection: after the first pairing, the device usually connects automatically when the vehicle is powered on next.

### VII. Administration panel - reporting issues and updating:

The adapter has an administration panel that allows for issue reporting and software updates.

#### Accessing the panel:

1. Connect the adapter to a stable 5 V power source (e.g., USB charger). It is not recommended to perform updates via the CarPlay port in the vehicle.
  2. On your phone, connect to the device's Wi-Fi network starting with **3mk\_DriveLink**
  3. If prompted for a password, enter: (in some versions, default: 88888888).
  4. Open a web browser and enter the address: <http://192.168.1.101>
- Issue Submission:**
1. Access the administration panel.
  2. Choose the "Problem Description" or "Issue Submission" tab.

3. Describe the issue in the text field.

4. Click "Submit."

5. Take a screenshot of the submission and provide it to the seller or service.

#### Software Update:

1. Access the administration panel.

2. Select "Online Update" or "Update."

3. If a new software version is available, confirm the update.

4. Wait for the process to finish. Do not disconnect the device during the update.

5. After completion, the device might reboot.

Updates may improve device stability, compatibility, and security.

### VIII. Troubleshooting:

#### The device does not appear on the Bluetooth list

Disconnect the adapter, restart the vehicle's multimedia system. Remove the device from the phone's Bluetooth list and pair it again.

#### CarPlay/Android Auto does not launch

Ensure that the adapter is connected to a USB port supporting factory CarPlay/Android Auto. Check if the feature is active in the vehicle.

#### Frequent disconnections

Disable aggressive power saving for Bluetooth/Wi-Fi on your phone. Perform a software update and pair again.

### IX. Information on disposal and recycling:
