

Safety Instructions for the Installation and Use of a Tempered Glass Screen Protector

1. Preparation before installation

- Choose a clean, dust-free and well-lit location with a flat surface.
- Wash your hands thoroughly before installation to avoid leaving greasy marks on the glass or screen.
- Turn off the device before starting the application so you can clearly see any contaminants on the screen.
- Make sure you have all necessary accessories: wet cleaning wipe, dry microfibre cloth, dust removal stickers.

2. Safe application of the glass

- Clean the screen with the enclosed wet wipe, then wipe dry with a soft microfibre cloth.
- Use the dust removal stickers to remove remaining particles — even small contaminants cause air bubbles.
- Hold the glass by the edges only — do not touch the adhesive side.
- Do not bend the glass — although tempered glass is resistant to pressure, it is prone to cracking when flexed.
- Be careful with the glass edges — they may be susceptible to chipping on strong impact.
- Centre the glass precisely over the speaker, camera and buttons before adhering.
- Once adhered, press from the centre outward with a dry cloth. If the kit includes an applicator, follow the enclosed instructions. Do not discard the applicator — it can be reused when applying the second glass from the kit.
- The glass is single-use — once removed, it loses its adhesive properties. Always clean the screen thoroughly before applying a new one.

3. After installing the glass

- Avoid excessive pressure on the edges, especially when carrying the phone without a case.
- Regularly check the condition of the glass — cracks, chips or touchscreen issues are a signal to replace it immediately.

4. Use and maintenance

- Regularly clean the glass surface with a microfibre cloth. Avoid aggressive chemical agents.
- Tempered glass provides additional screen protection but is not indestructible. Drops from height or strong impacts may shatter it.
- Avoid contact with sharp objects — despite 9H hardness, deep scratches are possible with harder materials.
- Avoid extreme temperatures — they may weaken the adhesive layer (e.g. leaving the phone in direct sunlight).
- We recommend using the glass together with a 3mk protective case for full device protection.

5. Handling damaged glass

- Remove damaged glass carefully — lever up a corner with a piece of paper or fingernail at the screen corner.
- Do not use metal or sharp tools — they may scratch the screen.
- Exercise particular caution with cracked glass — fragments may be sharp and cause cuts.
- Dispose of used glass in accordance with local glass waste regulations.

Following the above guidelines will ensure correct application and use of the product, keeping your device safe. The manufacturer is not liable for damage resulting from improper installation or use contrary to these instructions.
