

# Safety Instructions for the Installation and Use of a Plastic Protective Case

## 1. Preparation before installation

- Make sure the case is designed for your specific device model — use only original or certified cases.
- Make sure the smartphone is turned off to avoid accidental screen operations.
- Thoroughly clean the smartphone surface, especially the back and sides, with a soft microfibre cloth.
- Check the case for any damage or contaminants before fitting — these may scratch the smartphone.

## 2. Installing the case

- Insert the phone into the case from one side — usually start with the top or the side with the volume buttons.
- Gently press the remaining edges to seat the phone securely. Make sure all corners are properly aligned.
- Do not use excessive force — the case should snap into place without significant resistance.
- Check that the case does not cover the ports, speakers, camera and buttons. All cut-outs should be precisely aligned.
- Make sure the case does not cover the phone's ventilation openings to avoid overheating the device.

## 3. Using the case

- Avoid prolonged exposure of the case to high temperatures (e.g. direct sunlight) — this may cause the plastic to deform.
- Avoid dropping the phone from height — the case protects against minor shocks and scratches but may not withstand strong impacts.
- When charging, make sure the case does not block the charging cable or wireless charging port (if supported).
- Avoid contact of the case with chemical substances (e.g. solvents, oils) — these may damage the plastic.
- If the case becomes loose or damaged (cracks, deformations), replace it with a new one to ensure full phone protection.
- For intensive use, consider combining the case with a 3mk protective film or tempered glass for better screen protection.

## 4. Maintenance and cleaning

- Remove the case from the phone before cleaning.
- Wash the case with warm water and mild soap or a plastic cleaning agent.
- Dry the case thoroughly with a soft cloth before putting it back on the phone.
- Recommended cleaning frequency: once every 1–2 weeks to prevent the build-up of dust and bacteria.
- Regularly remove the case and clean the smartphone surface underneath — accumulated dust can scratch the back of the device.

## 5. Removing the case

- Gently bend one of the case corners, starting from the bottom of the smartphone.
- Gradually remove the case from the remaining phone edges.
- Avoid pulling the phone out forcefully to avoid damaging the device or the case.

## 6. Safety precautions

- Do not use a damaged case — it may not provide adequate phone protection.
- If using hybrid or tempered glass — check that the case edge does not overlap the glass. A case that is too tight may cause the screen protector to gradually peel off.
