

Safety Instructions for the Installation and Use of a Screen Protective Film

1. Preparation before installation

- Choose a clean, dust-free and dry location for applying the film — a bathroom right after a shower works best, as steam settles airborne dust.
- Wash your hands thoroughly before installation to avoid leaving greasy marks on the film or screen.
- Turn off the device before starting the application so you can clearly see any contaminants on the screen.
- Make sure you have all necessary accessories: microfibre cloth, alcohol wipe (if included in the kit), Dust-Fix™ stickers for removing dust particles, squeegee card for smoothing the film (if included).

2. Safe application of the film

- Clean the screen surface with the enclosed alcohol wipe, then wipe dry with the microfibre cloth.
- Use the Dust-Fix™ stickers to remove remaining dust particles — even small contaminants can cause air bubbles.
- Gently separate the film from the protective backing, being careful not to touch the adhesive side.
- Slowly apply the film to the screen, starting from one edge and gradually moving toward the other.
- Use the squeegee card or cloth to remove air bubbles, pushing them from the centre toward the screen edges. Small bubbles without dust will disappear on their own within 24–48 hours.
- Do not attempt to peel the film off forcefully during installation — this may damage the adhesive layer.

3. After installing the film

- Leave the device for a few hours after application so the adhesive can bond properly with the screen surface.
- Avoid pressing too hard on the film surface, especially at the edges, to prevent it from peeling off.
- Avoid contact with sharp objects that may damage or pierce the film.

4. Use and maintenance of the film

- Regularly clean the film surface with a microfibre cloth. Avoid chemical cleaning agents that may damage the film surface.
- Protect the phone from extreme temperatures that may affect the adhesive properties of the film (e.g. direct sunlight or frost).
- Avoid bending the film during removal to prevent permanent deformation.
- Regularly check the condition of the film to avoid problems with screen visibility or touchscreen performance.
- The film protects the screen from scratches but does not provide full protection against drops. It is recommended to use the film together with a 3mk protective case.

5. Handling a damaged film

- If the film becomes damaged (cracked, torn, detached), replace it immediately to ensure continued protection of the device screen.
- When removing the film, exercise caution — gently lift a corner and pull slowly to avoid scratching the screen surface.
- Dispose of the used film in accordance with local plastic waste segregation regulations.

Following the above guidelines will ensure correct application and use of the product, keeping your device safe. The manufacturer is not liable for damage resulting from improper installation or use contrary to these instructions.
